Parishes are listed by percent of goal paid. The green highlights represent those parishes with more than 30 percent of families supporting the appeal.

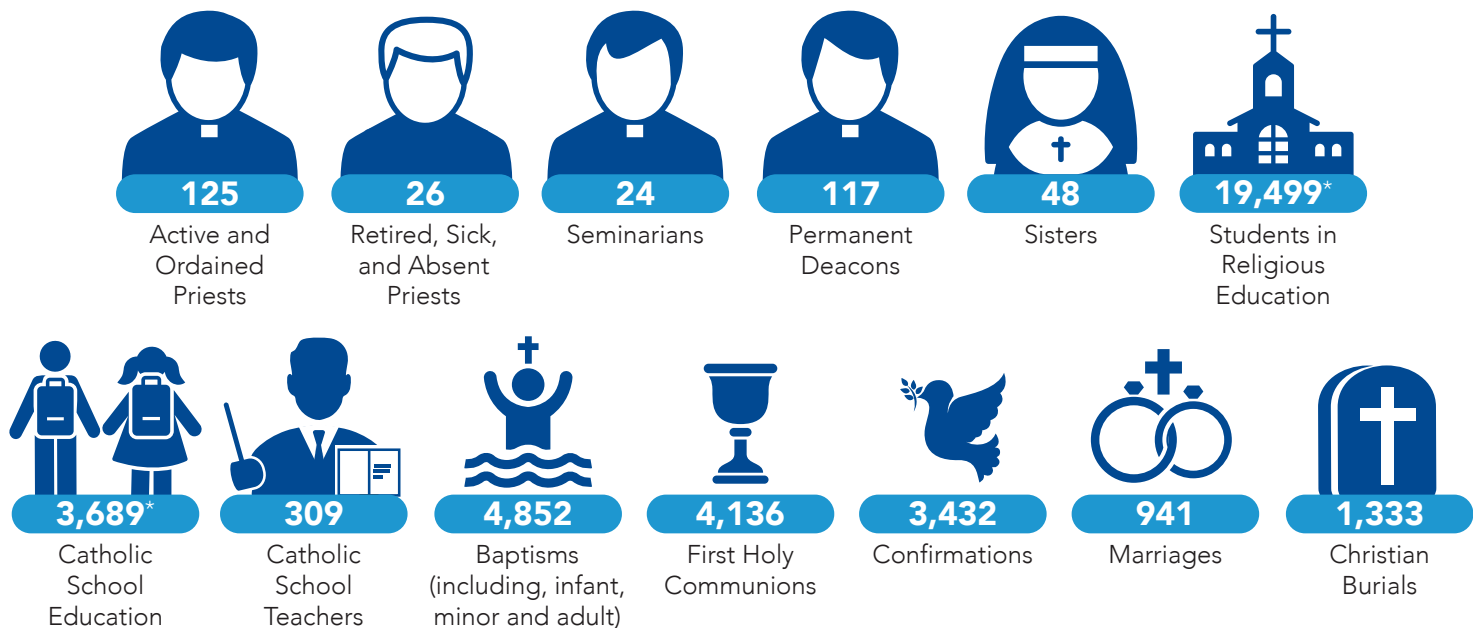

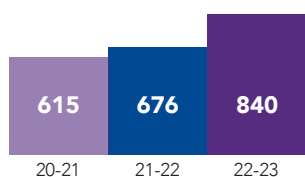
Your Gift Counts Unique ways you make an impact



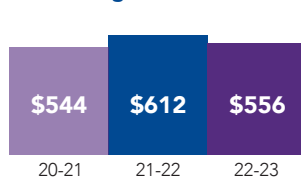

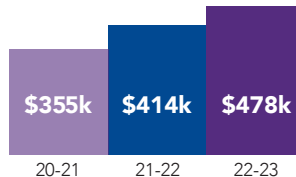

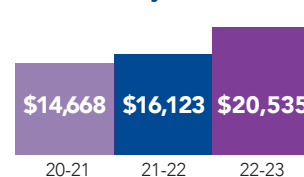
Average Annual Gift:



Total Gifts:









