

June 30 is the final day to support this year's campaign

The outpouring of generosity for the 2020 Annual Diocesan Appeal, especially during these unprecedented times, has been truly humbling.

Through April 15, 10,640 families have made commitments totaling \$3,311,930. Thank you!

The theme of this year's campaign - *The Eucharist Makes Us the Church* - is being embraced by Catholics throughout the Diocese of Fort Worth. We are called to share in the redemptive work of Christ and supporting the vital needs the Appeal makes possible allows us to respond in gratitude.

This year, when so many of our parishes are struggling with declining offertories and our schools are facing budget shortfalls, the need for funding for parish and school operating grants is critical. 
